#### Instructions to student

Use this form if you are planning to attend a postsecondary school outside Ontario (except McGill University (Quebec), Concordia University (Quebec) or Dalhousie University (Nova Scotia)).

Complete the Student Information section on pages 1 and 2. Then give all pages of this form to an official at your school who is authorized to confirm your program details and costs. Authorized officials can include staff in the office of the Registrar, financial aid office or enrolment services. The school official will return the completed form to you.

Submit all pages of your completed form to the ministry for processing.

#### **Deadline**

The completed form must be received by the ministry no later than 40 days before the end of your study period.

#### Instructions to school official

This form is used to gather the student's information for a study period that starts anytime between August 1, 2023 and July 31, 2024 inclusive. The student doesn't have to be currently registered or attending your school to complete this form.

Complete this form only if you are authorized to confirm the student's program details and costs (e.g. you work in the office of Registrar, financial aid office or enrolment services). Once you have provided the information requested and have signed the declaration, return the completed form to the student. If you're unable to complete the form because the instructions indicate "stop here and return form to student", the student is not eligible for OSAP funding and can discuss their situation with the ministry.
