

Purpose

Use this form to request only the grant(s) you are eligible to receive and to decline the Canada-Ontario Integrated Student Loan. In order to make this request, you must have already submitted a 2026-27 OSAP Application for Full-Time Students.

To decline all of your loan:

Your form must be received by your financial aid office no later than 40 days before the start of your study period.

To decline only the second instalment of your loan:

Your form must be received by your financial aid office no later than 40 days before the release of your 2nd loan installment.

If you've received all of your loan:

It is too late to request grant only. However, you can repay your loan immediately. Contact the National Student Loans Service Centre (NSLSC) for details.

Changed your mind?

If you decide later that you want the loan, contact your financial aid office no later than 40 days before the end of your study period. You will receive the amount of loan that hasn't already been released. If you have not received any of your loan, you will get both installments.

Why your grants could be turned into a loan

Normally, OSAP grants are money you don't need to pay back. However, all or part of your OSAP grants may be converted into a loan if:

- You withdraw from studies or stop taking the minimum course load within the first 30 days of starting school and don't return as a full-time student within 5 months in the same academic year.
- As a result of an OSAP reassessment, you're not entitled to all or part of the grant that you received (e.g., dropped courses, underreported income).
- The income provided by you and/or your family cannot be verified within one year from the start of your studies (this applies only to the Ontario Student Grant).

If your grant is converted to a loan, it's:

- added to your loan balance.
- included in the calculation of the monthly loan payment you'll make once you're done school.

How to submit this form

You can upload your completed form online. Log into the OSAP web site and go to your application to use the "Print or upload documents" option. Or, you can submit a paper copy as follows:
